



# FLEX



## Spanish Localization

Flex Designer has the ability to display the text language inside the software as Spanish. If the system language is Spanish, Flex Designer will automatically use Spanish as the default language in the software.

To manually change the language within Flex Designer to Spanish:

1. Right click the Flex Designer shortcut.
2. Select "Properties" at the bottom of the list of options.
3. Under "Target:" scroll to the end of the text (including quotations) and add " -c es" (excluding quotations).  
e.g. If default pathing is used the full text will read:

"C:\Program Files (x86)\Flex AV\Designer\FLEX.Designer.UI.exe" -c es

4. Select OK

Flex Designer should now display text in Spanish when opened.
